



RMKO Records 3.1-Fold Surge in TLS Volume Driven by Full Hauling Road Operations

Jakarta, April 9, 2026 PT Royaltama Mulia Kontraktorindo Tbk (RMKO IJ) an integrated mining services company focused on heavy equipment rental and construction, today announced solid operational achievements for the period up to February 2026. This positive performance was driven by effective operational synergy, particularly the full utilization of the hauling road owned by its group company, PT RMK Energi Tbk (RMKE IJ), as well as a strategic response to market dynamics and regulations.

Strong Growth in Heavy Equipment Rental & Transportation Segment

RMKO's heavy equipment rental segment showed sustained growth momentum. Transportation volume through the Train Loading Station (TLS) facility increased **3.1-fold** compared to the same period last year. This increase was supported by a rise in coal loaded via rail by **275.2 thousand tons**, a significant jump from 88.7 thousand tons in the same period last year.

This TLS performance was bolstered by a **24.0% year-on-year (yoy)** growth in coal hauling volume, from 45.0 thousand tons to **55.8 thousand tons**. In addition to the volume handled directly by RMKO, TLS volume was also boosted by hauling activities conducted by third parties using the same hauling road, reflecting the strategic value of this infrastructure.

Expansion of Mining Services to Third Parties

In the mining services segment, RMKO has begun handling mining operations for third parties that have been RMKE's customers since 2025. Through a coal purchase option scheme at the mine mouth, RMKO not only provides operational services but also offers integrated solutions that enhance value for partners.

As of February 2026, the Company successfully increased overburden removal (OB removal) volume from third-party mines by **33.0% yoy** to **212.5 thousand bcm**. Furthermore, coal volume produced from third-party mines also increased, reaching **49.1 thousand tons**.

Commitment Amid Operational Challenges

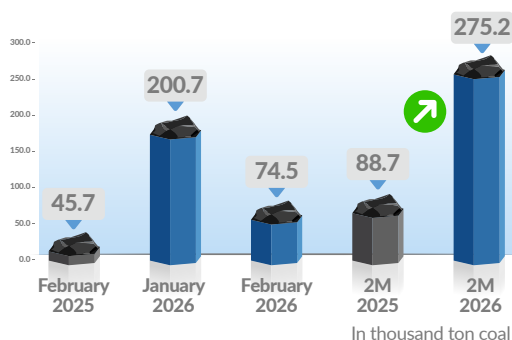
RMKO's President Director, William Saputra, acknowledged existing operational constraints. "The hauling and TLS loading volume temporarily tended to slow due to weather disruptions, mining administration processes (RKAB), and the ongoing low season period. However, encouragingly, RMKO was still able to demonstrate a consistent upward trend through February 2026," he stated.

William emphasized that the completion and full operation of the RMKE hauling road facility has delivered a tangible positive impact on RMKO's business. This momentum is further strengthened by the implementation of the **Regional Government Regulation prohibiting the use of public roads for coal transportation**, effective since 1 January 2026.

"This regulation further solidifies the position of our hauling road as vital and strategic infrastructure in our operating area. Going forward, we will continue to strengthen inter-group synergy to drive increased coal volumes from third-party mines, fully supported by well-integrated supporting infrastructure facilities," William concluded.

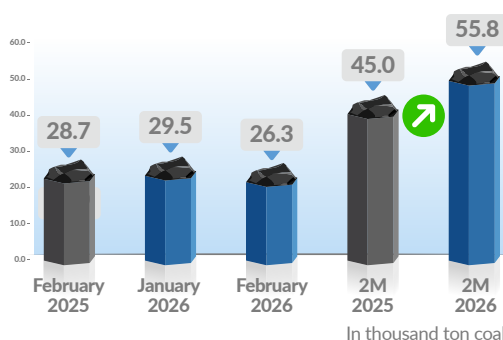
Loading TLS
